



PUBLIC UTILITY DISTRICT NO 1. OF KITTITAS COUNTY – SCHEDULE 1008

Medium Irrigation Service – Single Phase

Availability:

Available to single phase motor or pump loads between 7.5kW and 75kW metered separately for irrigation purposes. Single phase to three phase conversion may be allowed under this rate with District approval. All motor or pump loads connected under this rate schedule must have starting equipment that meets the approval of the District. Services connected under this schedule have an average metered demand between 7.5 kW and 75 kW per month. Any single phase service which exceeds 75 kW in three (3) or more non-consecutive months during a twelve (12) month period, is not available under this rate and will be moved to Large Irrigation Service – Rate Schedule 1010. Service hereunder is subject to the established rules and regulations of the District.

Type of Service:

Single phase at available secondary voltages, normally 120/240 or 240/480.

Monthly Rate:

Minimum Charge.....	\$22.50/month
Energy Charge.....	\$.0800/kWh
Demand Charge.....	\$5.92/kW

Determination of Billing Demand:

The billing demand shall be the maximum kilowatt load used by the consumer for any consecutive 15-minute period during the month as indicated or recorded by a demand meter.

Minimum Charge:


The minimum monthly charge under this rate schedule shall be \$22.50. Any energy or demand charges incurred each month reduce this charge. If the sum of energy charge and demand charge exceeds \$22.50 no minimum charge is incurred in that month. If there is no energy charge or demand charge in any given month, then the minimum charge is applied for that month.


Power Factor:

The customer agrees to maintain unity power factor as nearly as practicable. Demand charges will be adjusted to correct for average power factor lower than 95%.

Terms of Payment:

Payable upon receipt. Bills unpaid after the due date will be charged interest at the rate of 1% monthly.
