



PUBLIC UTILITY DISTRICT NO 1. OF KITTITAS COUNTY – SCHEDULE 1009

Medium Irrigation Service – Three Phase

Availability:

Available to three phase motor or pump loads 10hp (7.5kW) or greater metered separately for irrigation purposes. All motors connected under this rate must have starting equipment that meets the approval of the District. Services connected under this schedule have an average usage of less than 50,000kwh per month. Any service which exceeds 50,000kwh in three (3) or more non-consecutive months during a twelve (12) month period, is not available under this rate and will be moved to large irrigation - Rate Schedule 1010. Service hereunder is subject to the established rules and regulations of the District.

Type of Service:

Three phase at available voltages, normally 120/240, 240/480 or 277/480.

Monthly Rate:

Minimum Charge:
Three Phase \$24.25/month

Energy Charge:
All kWh \$.0760/kWh

Demand Charge:
All kW \$5.64/kW

Determination of Billing Demand:

The billing demand shall be the maximum kilowatt load used by the consumer for any consecutive 15-minute period during the month as indicated or recorded by a demand meter.

Minimum Charge:

The minimum monthly charge under this rate shall be \$24.25 for single phase accounts. Any energy charges incurred each month reduce this charge. If the sum of energy charges and/or demand charges exceed \$24.25 there is no minimum charge in that month. If there is no energy charges and demand charges in any given month, then the minimum charge is applied for that month.


Power Factor:

The customer agrees to maintain unity power factor as nearly as practicable. Demand charges will be adjusted to correct for average power factor lower than 95%.

Terms of Payment:

Payable upon receipt. Bills unpaid after the due date will be charged interest at the rate of 1% monthly.
