



PUBLIC UTILITY DISTRICT NO 1. OF KITTITAS COUNTY – SCHEDULE 1002

Large Commercial Service – Distribution

Availability:

Available to large single and three phase customers for all uses. Services connected under this schedule have a service entrance rating larger than 400A single phase or 200A three phase and average usage of greater than 35,000kwh per month. Single phase motors of 7.5 hp or less may be connected to this schedule. All motors of larger sizes shall be three phase unless approved by the District. Highly intermittent power loads such as x-ray machines, elevators, and similar loads which may cause undue fluctuations, will not be served unless approved by the District. Service hereunder is subject to the established rules and regulations of the District.

Type of Service:

Single phase at available voltages, normally 120/240 or 240/480.
Three phase at available voltages, normally 120/208, 240/480 or 277/480.

Monthly Rate:

Facilities Charge:
Single Phase \$53.25/month
Three Phase \$103.25/month

Energy Charge:
First 20,000 kWh \$.0794/kWh
Over 20,000 kWh..... \$.0510/kWh

Demand Charge:
First 25 kW or less..... No Charge
Over 25 kW \$5.64/kW

Determination of Billing Demand:

The billing demand shall be the maximum kilowatt load used by the consumer for any consecutive 15-minute period during the month as indicated or recorded by a demand meter.

Minimum Charge:

The minimum monthly charge under this rate shall be \$53.25 for single phase and \$103.25 for three phase accounts.

Power Factor:

The customer agrees to maintain unity power factor as nearly as practicable. Demand charges will be adjusted to correct for average power factor lower than 95%.

Terms of Payment:

Payable upon receipt. Bills unpaid after the due date will be charged interest at the rate of 1% monthly.
